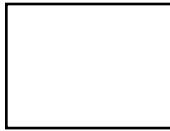


# Make Plans to Participate and Make a Difference



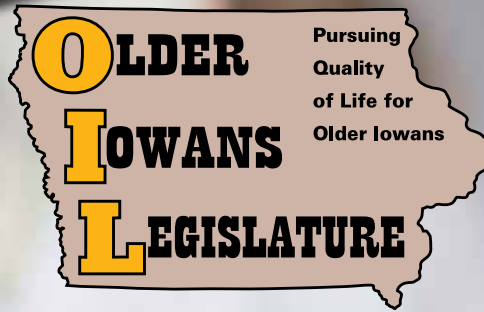

## What is the Older Iowans Legislature?

The Older Iowans Legislature is a statewide non-partisan, non-profit volunteer organization. Its members advocate for state legislators, and the Governor to sign, legislation that will result in an improved "Quality of Life for Older Iowans."

OIL was formed in 1978 by the Department of Elder Affairs and Area Agencies on Aging. It was officially authorized by the State Legislature.



## OIL's Past Achievements:

- Expanded Elder Abuse Law.
- Increased funding for Home and Community Based Services.
- Volunteer Ombudsmen Program.
- Increased personal allowance for persons in nursing homes.
- Substitute Decision Maker Program.



## OIL's Goals

- Further expand the Elder Abuse law
- Protect vulnerable nursing home residents from aggressive residents including registered sex offenders.
- Increase funding for the Long-Term Care Ombudsman program.
- Increase funding for the Substitute Decision Maker program.
- Establish a Long Term Care Committee to facilitate a coordinated approach to the delivery of Long Term Care in Iowa.
